### Chronicle Dome Run slated

The Houston Chronicle Dome Run is set for Labor Day, Monday, Sept. 1. The 10K (6.2-mile) race will begin on the Astrodome parking lot at 8 a.m., proceeding along a scenic University Boulevard course before returning to the finish line on the floor of the stadium.

Through Aug. 25 the entry fee is \$11. From Aug. 26-31, the fee is \$13. Race day registration is \$25. Those registering on race day should use the Astrodome West entrance. A portion of each individual entry goes to benefit the Muscular Dystrophy Association.


Race finishers will be given an official Dome Run T-Shirt and a Miller Lite painter's cap. Runners packets will contain Houston Chronicle sweatbands, Astros game tickets for the Sunday, Aug. 31 game against the Pirates and also for the Sept. 7 game against the Cardinals,

as well as passes to Astroworld/Waterworld and other coupons.

Packets will be available for pick up at the Quality Royale Hotel next to the Astrodome on Kirby Drive on Aug. 29, 30 and 31 from 11 a.m. to 8 p.m. The top runners will compete for \$6,000 in cash. The top runners, along with winners in 20 age categories, also will receive wrist watches from Gordon's Jewelry. A drawing for other prizes will also be held.

Corporate teams consisting of three to five runners will compete for the Corporate Cup, as well as Continental Airline tickets. The corporate entry fee of \$275 benefits the Muscular Dystrophy Association and is fully tax-deductible.

## Sharon Wagner's First Annual 36th Birthday Run

In honor of this auspicious occasion, the Hash Run has been designed around the theme of 36.

If you examine the number 36 closely, you will notice a couple of things:

-If you multiply the number 36 by itself, then divide by the average Hasher I.Q. (1.945), you come up with 666, which is the Mark of the Devil. This is very significant.
